



EARLY ADMISSION Informed Consent Agreement and Release of Liability for Parent/Guardian

This is an *Informed Consent Form* for parents/guardians which provides information relevant to students applying for early admission at Snow College.

Dear Parent/Guardian. Your son or daughter is being considered for early admission at Snow College. This is an exciting opportunity, but we would like to make sure that you understand some of what this means.

Early admission is conditional. Students thus admitted are only eligible to enroll in classes one semester at a time and will only be allowed to continue enrolling if he/she earns a semester grade point average of 2.00 or higher.

Your son or daughter will be learning, interacting, and socializing with students who are adults. Also, your son or daughter will have access to the full range of services and activities Snow College provides. Some of those are listed below.

PART 1: SERVICES/ACTIVITIES.

1. **Classes.** Your son or daughter will be taking regular college classes, which are designed for and will be attended by mature students usually age 18 and above. These courses may contain material or subject matter of a more rigorous and/or mature nature. You may want to review a syllabus or speak with a professor before your child enrolls in a specific class.
2. **Counseling and Wellness Center.** Your child will have access to all the services the campus Counseling and Wellness Center provides. This includes counseling.
3. **Testing.** This includes assessment, placement, and course testing services.
4. **Library.** The library is open to all students and all materials are generally available without censorship. This includes materials intended for mature persons.
5. **Internet Access.** Your son or daughter will have access to the campus computer labs and the campus wide Wi-Fi system. There are no filters on the internet services the College provides. Network users are expected to accept and abide by a technology user agreement.
6. **Campus Recreation.** Any activity, program, meetings, clubs, athletic events, etc. that are open to regular admit students are open to early admit students. This includes attending and participating in campus recreation on and off campus.
7. **Campus Housing.** Your student can apply for and receive campus housing. Assignments to rooms with similar aged students will be attempted.
8. **Fitness Facilities.** Fulltime students (12+ credits) have access to all on campus physical fitness facilities.

In addition, Snow College will not act in loco parentis to your child. You retain the duty to supervise and regulate their behavior and choices.
