What Degree Can I Get at Snow?

As an architecture major, you will want a degree that will transfer to a four-year college or university - either an Associate of Science (AS) or an Associate of Arts (AA) degree. In Utah, the only architecture program is at the University of Utah. There are also programs at the University of Nevada in Las Vegas, Montana State University in Bozeman, and University of Idaho in Pocatello.

What Classes Should I Take?

You will want to take the following types of classes:

General Education + Major Requirements + Recommended Classes + Electives.

General Education classes are designed to provide you with a broad knowledge of many subjects such as Fine Arts, Literature, Biology, etc. Major Requirements are classes that you are expected to take *as a freshman and a sophomore* so that you can transfer as a junior in your major. Recommended classes are those that we believe will provide key background for your major, even though they are not required. Electives are courses that you want to take "*just to learn stuff!*"

To earn an AS or an AA degree, you will need 63 total credits, and about half of these will be General Education credits.
