

### What Degree Can I Get?

The Associate Science Business (ASB) degree requires a minimum of 63 credits. It is designed for the student who wants to transfer to a four year institution as a business major. Please note that a business major includes all business programs e.g., accounting, administration, finance, human resource management, ect. This degree allows the students to transfer with advanced standing which means that the student is a junior and can register for upper division classes (Catalog p. 99).



### ***Associate of Science in Business (ASB)***

- This is a degree that prepares you to transfer to a four-year college in Utah in majors such as business administration, accounting, or management information systems. To get this degree, you take 31 General Education credits, plus all of the “pre-business core” classes.

### ***Associate of Science or Associate of Arts (AS/AA)***

- These degrees prepare you to transfer to a four-year college in Utah. This option may work for you if, for some reason, you can complete all of your General Education requirements and 32 elective credits and only some of the “pre-business core” classes while you are at Snow.
