

The Commercial Drivers License program provides the training and testing needed to obtain a Class "A" CDL. The course is open enrollment and self-paced. Students are provided home study materials for the scholastic part of the course. The skills portion of the course is covered by one-on-one training appointments with instructors and can be varied to suit individual needs. Credit is also available for the CLD courses.



These courses prepare the student for different parts of the CDL exam:

- DMT 1810 – prepares the student for the written part of the Class "A" Commercial Drivers License
- DMT 1820 – prepares the student for the Class "A" CDL Basic Skills Performance exam
- DMT 1825 – prepares the student for Class "A" CDL Road Test Performance exam
- DMT 1830 – provides students with preparation for an additional Certificate.
- DMT 1840 – prepares the student for the written, Pre-Trip Inspection and Basic Skills portions of the Class "B" CDL.

Most courses require additional fees. All classes require instructor permission for enrollment. Students must be able to meet CDL physical requirements.
