

What Degree Can I Get?

- The Honors Classes meet the needs of academically prepared students who intend to transfer to a university to complete a BS or BA degree.
- The classes are small to create a friendly environment for lecture/discussion.
- Also, Honors Classes have field trips to enhance the classroom experience.
- The Honors Classes keep students on track so that they are prepared to transfer and graduate on time, whether they have declared their major or are not.



Which Classes Should I Take?

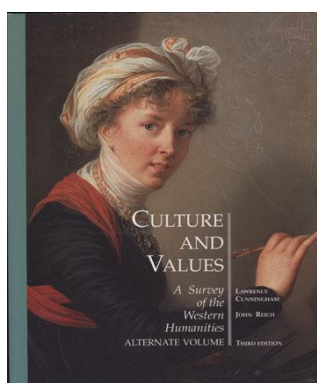
The Honors Program requires students to complete 12 hours of Honors classes.

Students may petition the Honors Committee for substitutions such as Calculus for Honors Math, English 2160 for English 2150, or a science 2800 Special Projects class for English 2014.

- Students with a B+ GPA or 26 ACT are accepted into the program and may register for any Honors Classes.
- Students register for Honors classes the same way that they register for their other classes.
- Students starting the program should register for English 2150 Honors Intellectual Traditions Fall semester.
