

What can I do with a Nursing Assistant certificate?

Students who complete the program are prepared to take the state certification exam. The Nursing Assistant Certification exam now includes Home Health Aide Certification. Upon successful completion of this exam, students may then find career opportunities in such places as hospitals, long-term care facilities, assisted living communities as well as Home Health Aides.



Facts at a Glance:

- The average starting wage is between \$8.00 and \$11.00 per hour according to the website, <http://online.onetcenter.org/>.
- Certified Nursing Assistants are responsible for basic care services of patients.
- Students must be at least 16 years of age.
- Students can complete this course in one college semester with approximately 125 hours of combined classroom lecture, skills lab and clinical hours.
- Students must pass a criminal back ground check prior to beginning the class.
- Snow College offers this program in Richfield, Ephraim, Delta, Eureka, Fillmore, Nephi, Piute and Wayne.

PRE-ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

BEFORE YOU CAN BE ENROLLED YOU MUST:

- Be at least 16 years old and a junior in high school. Preference will be given to those who are 17.
- Must have at least a 2.0 high school cumulative grade point average (GPA); **or**
- Have an ACT score of 16 in math, and a 15 in reading; **or**
- Have completed 12 college credits successfully.
- Be able to pass a fingerprint and background check.
(The fingerprint form and notary signature page needs to be sent to the state a week before class begins)

This course is offered FALL, SPRING or SUMMER at the various locations and is a one semester course.

ADDITIONAL PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- Text Books (available in Bookstore)
- Scrubs (used for clinical only)
- TB Testing: You must have a current (yearly) copy of your TB Test results. (Cost: Approx. \$15) You can get it at the Central Utah Public Health Dept., Richfield, Mondays, from 9-12.
- Background checks are required **before** class begins. Forms are available in the registration office or from the nursing secretary (Amanda). **Please follow all directions.** Fingerprinting is done at the Sherriff's office in Richfield on Wednesdays from 4:00 – 6:00 pm. **This form must be notarized.**
- Any individual wanting to be a Certified Nurse Assistant must complete the CNA course at 80% or higher which qualifies you to take the following examinations for certification:
 - (a) The State Certification written exam (\$35)
 - (b) The State Certification skills test (\$70)
