Advisors are available to meet with Snow College students by appointment. Students may call 435-283-7313 to set up an appointment. Individual in-person interaction is preferred, but advisors will also work with students via email. Students should have at least an unofficial transcript available from all previously attended institutions prior to meeting with an advisor to ensure an accurate evaluation of academic standing and remaining educational requirements. An unofficial transcript can be downloaded from the college from which the credits were earned.
