

## What Degree Can I Get?

. Occupational Therapy majors at Snow will want to complete either an Associate of Science (AS) or an Associate of Arts (AA) degree. These are transfer degrees, designed to prepare you to transfer to a four-year college. The University of Utah is the only accredited occupational therapy program in the state of Utah. The U of U Occupational Therapy offers a three-year entry-level Masters degree. During this program students who enter without a bachelor's degree will receive a Bachelor of Occupational Therapy Studies after the first year and a Masters degree in Occupational Therapy at the end of the three-year program

Students who wish to transfer to a four-year institution should take the courses recommended below. Note that these recommendations represent a minimal commitment to studying Occupational Therapy. ## What is Occupational Therapy?

An occupational therapist is a health professional that works with individuals of all ages who due to challenges to their physical, emotional or social well being, need specialized help to lead independent, productive and satisfying lives. Graduates of an accredited therapy program are eligible to take the national certification examination.

An occupational therapist should be resourceful, compassionate, a good listener, a creative problem-solver and interested in health, science and the arts. Occupational therapy is a perfect blend of life science (anatomy and physiology) and social science (psychology and sociology). Occupational therapist has knowledge of the person and the environments and how to support the person in what they want and need to do. Occupational therapist make a difference!
