Register

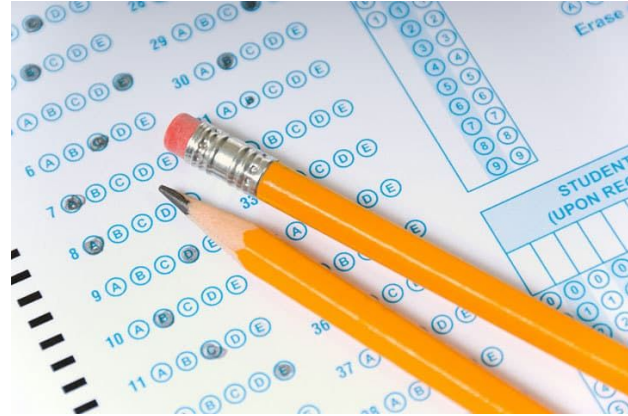
Once Badger ID is issued, the student may enroll in classes

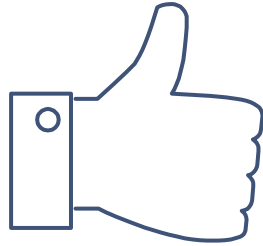
