

Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) (20 U.S.C. § 1232g; 34 CFR Part 99) is a Federal law that protects the privacy of student education records. The law applies to all schools that receive funds under an applicable program of the U.S. Department of Education.

FERPA gives parents certain rights with respect to their children's education records. These rights transfer to the student when he or she reaches the age of 18 or attends a school beyond the high school level (Snow College). Students to whom the rights have transferred are "eligible students."

Once a student reaches 18 years of age or attends a postsecondary institution (Snow College), he or she becomes an "eligible student," and all rights formerly given to parents under FERPA transfer to the student.

If parent(s), guardian(s) or a high school counselor of a Snow College student enrolled in a Snow College course desires to discuss the student's performance or academic record with a professor, the parent, guardian or counselor must receive permission from the student. This permission must be received in writing. This form can be filled out and signed by the student and sent to the Snow College Registrar's Office who will notify the professor of the permission.
