- New Financial Aid Regulations and Repeatable Courses

New regulations will only fund a student for taking a class two times

Exceptions: performance based (convocations, private lessons, musical performance groups). However, it would help Financial Aid to have musical performance based courses be first year, second year, etc. In addition Community Outreach, International Partners need to be changed to first year, second year.

Intercollegiate sports would be ok to have one repeatable course.

New programs approved by our institution and the Board of Regents must also be approved by the Department of Education if you want a student to be financial aid eligible. It is a four-six month process.
