

As part of the accreditation process, Snow College is scheduled to submit a comprehensive report of Institutional Effectiveness and host a committee of peers for an on-site evaluation on October 12-14, 2020.

Accreditation is an ongoing status that must be reaffirmed periodically. Every institution is to conduct a self-study and be visited by an evaluation committee of the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Schools periodically during a seven-year cycle. The purpose of this visit is to complete a full-scale evaluation of the mission, effectiveness, programs, services, and policies of the College. Snow College is currently fully accredited by the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities; that status was granted in 1953 and was most recently reaffirmed in February 2012.

Individuals are invited to send comments directly to the Commission. Comments are considered regarding an institution's qualification for candidacy or accreditation. Signed comments are forwarded, as received, to the institution, evaluation committee, and the Commission. Comments can be submitted to the address below and must be received no later than September12, 2020
