As a routine part of the accreditation process, Snow College is scheduled to submit a Comprehensive Self-Evaluation Report and host a committee of peers for an on-site evaluation on October 1-3, 2012.

Accreditation is an ongoing status that must be reaffirmed periodically. Every institution is to conduct a self-study and be visited by an evaluation committee of the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Schools periodically during a seven-year cycle. The purpose of this visit is to complete a full-scale evaluation of the programs, services, and policies of the College. Snow College is currently fully accredited by the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities; that status was granted in 1953 and was most recently reaffirmed in February, 2012.

Individuals are invited to send comments directly to the Commission. Comments are considered with regard to an institution's qualification for candidacy or accreditation. Signed comments are forwarded, as received, to the institution, evaluation committee, and the Commission. Comments can be submitted to the address below and must be received no later than September 1, 2012.
