

### POTENTIAL NAIL TECHNOLOGY STUDENT

- ➤ Information form with student signature and parent's signature required for high school students.
- ➤ 2 Letters of Recommendation (not from family)
- Letter of intent...introduce yourself, include your goals and why you are interested in cosmetology.
- ➤ High school transcript, copy of high school diploma or GED, or explanation why it is not included.

The nail technology applications will be due in the registration office according to the following schedule:

Fall Semester Application deadline: May 1
Spring Semester Application deadline: October 1
Summer Semester Application deadline: April 1

#### **Nail Technology Course**

**Course Objective:** To complete 300 hours of training required for state licensure as a nail technician.

Must be enrolled in and complete all 4 courses at a passing score of 70% or higher. Failure to pass ALL 4 classes at a 70% or higher will result in having to take the classes again in a future semester with the additional cost of taking the

course over.

Course Number and Title: TENT 1110-Nail Technician I, 4 credits

TENT 1200-Nail Technician II Clinical, 2 credits

TENT 1600- Advanced Techniques Class/Lab, 2 credits TENT 1610- Nail Technician Business Basics, 1 credit

Course Schedule:

Fall Semester: August - December from 7:45—12:30 pm Mon-Friday Spring Semester: January - April from 7:45 – 12:30 pm Mon-Friday Summer Semester: May- July - Monday-Thursday 7:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m.

Friday- 7:30 a.m. -12:30 p.m.

NOTE: Portions of the nail class will be taught using Hybrid technologies

Classes will follow the Snow College Richfield Campus school calendar and all holidays will be observed as specified on the Snow College Academic calendar.

Note: Students missing class will have to make up time, by arranging with the instructor. If a student does not meet the hour requirements by the end of the semester, the student will have to finish the needed hours during the next semester with the associated extra costs. There are a few extra days at the end of each class semester for makeup days. If more time is needed in order to meet the required 300 hours of training to qualify for the licensing test, additional tuition will be charged based on the number of makeup hours needed, as stated above. NOTE: This class cannot accommodate a high school A/B schedule.

**Course Costs:** 

\*College tuition (see current tuition table + \$30 application fee)

8<sup>th</sup> edition Milady Standard Nail Technology textbook, (with CIMA 1year access) and the Foundations text book <u>MUST</u> be purchased from (snowbookstore.com)

Books are required for the first day of class.

<sup>\*</sup>High school student tuition is \$45.00 plus \$30 application fee

<sup>\*</sup>Ask the Student Success office for the current tuition rate.

<sup>\*</sup>Upon acceptance to the course tuition and fees must be paid in full or payment arrangement made in the Richfield cashiers office prior to the first day of class.

<sup>\*</sup>Books & supplies are approximately \$850 (subject to change).

\*Smocks, nail product and implement kit will be purchased in the Cosmetology department. The nail instructors will tell you when those items need to be purchased.

**Registration:** 

Registration will be based upon completion of the application process. Which consists of an application to the college and a completed nail application turned in by the due date and followed up with an interview. **Incomplete applications will be rejected so make sure the application in complete.** 

**Important notes:** 

This course alone does not carry enough credits to be eligible for federal financial aid or Veteran benefits. You may want to consider additional classes.
