Section 205 Establishment

53B-16-205. Establishment

(1) There is established a board of higher education.

(2) Snow College shall administer Snow College's mission, vision, and values.

(3) Snow College shall:

(a) maintain a strong culture of excellence at Snow College which can be required for association membership;

(b) work with school districts to develop a Richfield campus; and

(c) provide, through the low cost tuition rate, a pathway for students to gain placement in the job market.

(i) the Juab School District;

(ii) the Millard School District;

(iii) the Tintic School District;

(iv) the North Sanpete School District;

- ***(2)(a) Provide a consistent two-year schedule of concurrent enrollment courses delivered through interactive video conferencing to secondary school students;***
- ***a pathway for a secondary school students particularly in rural high schools to earn college credits;***

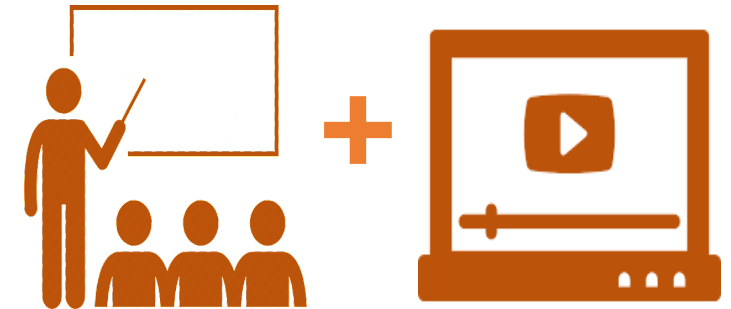

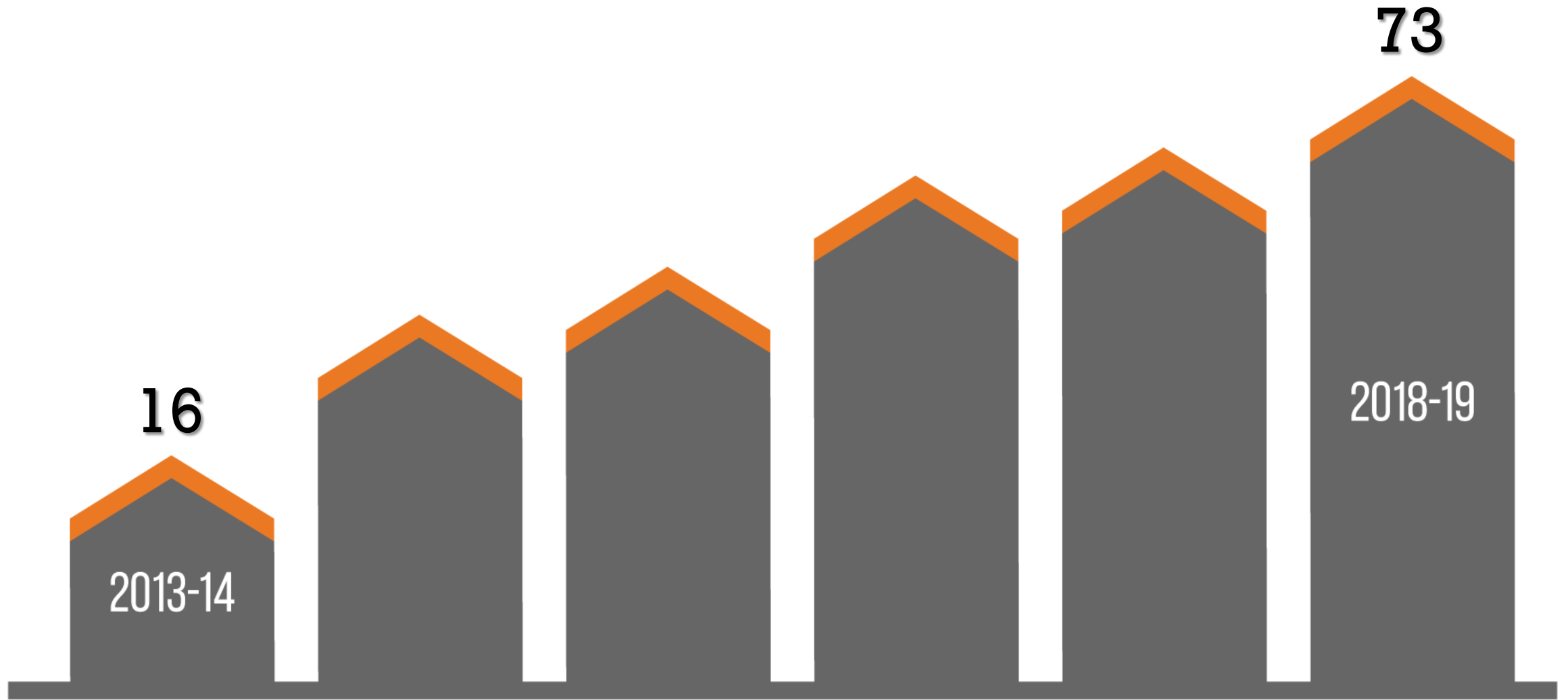

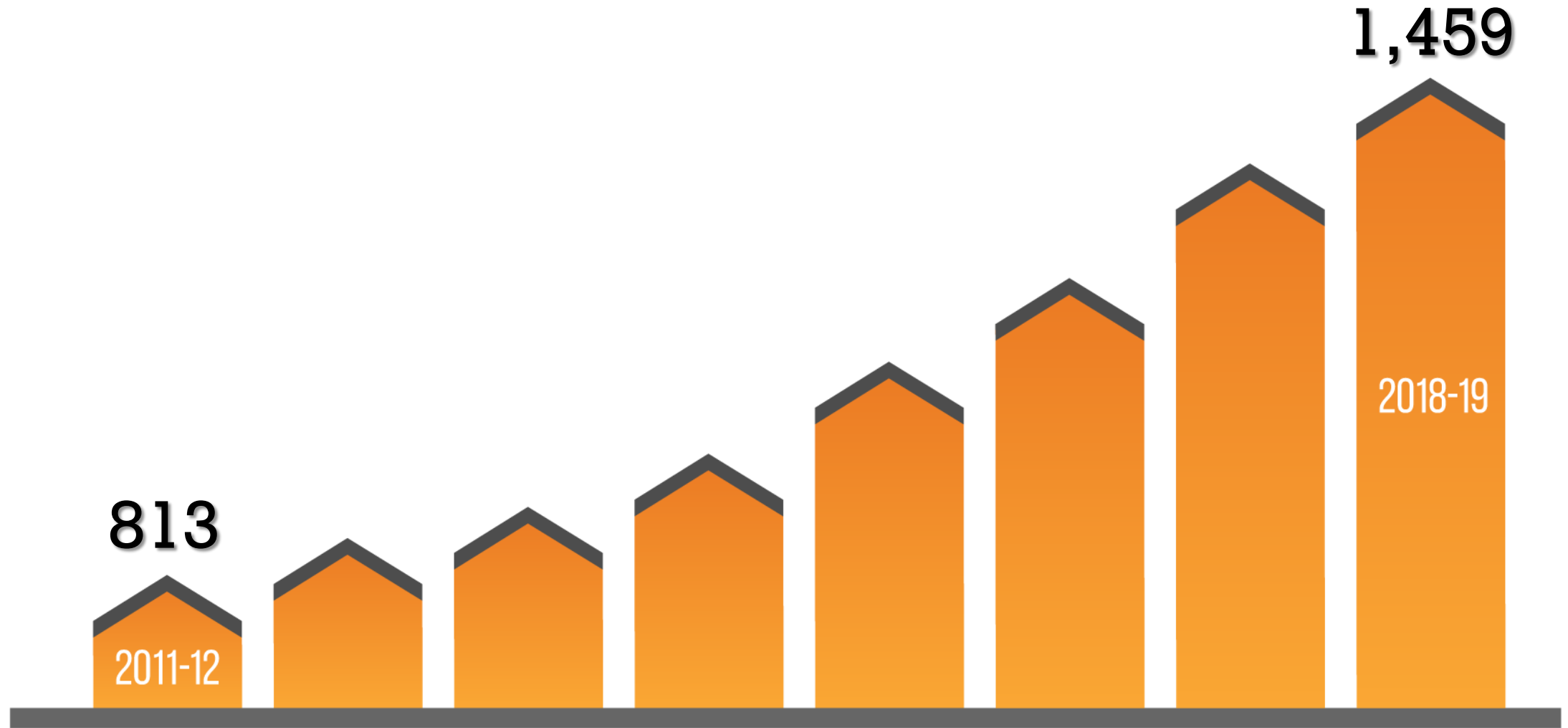
Number of Schools



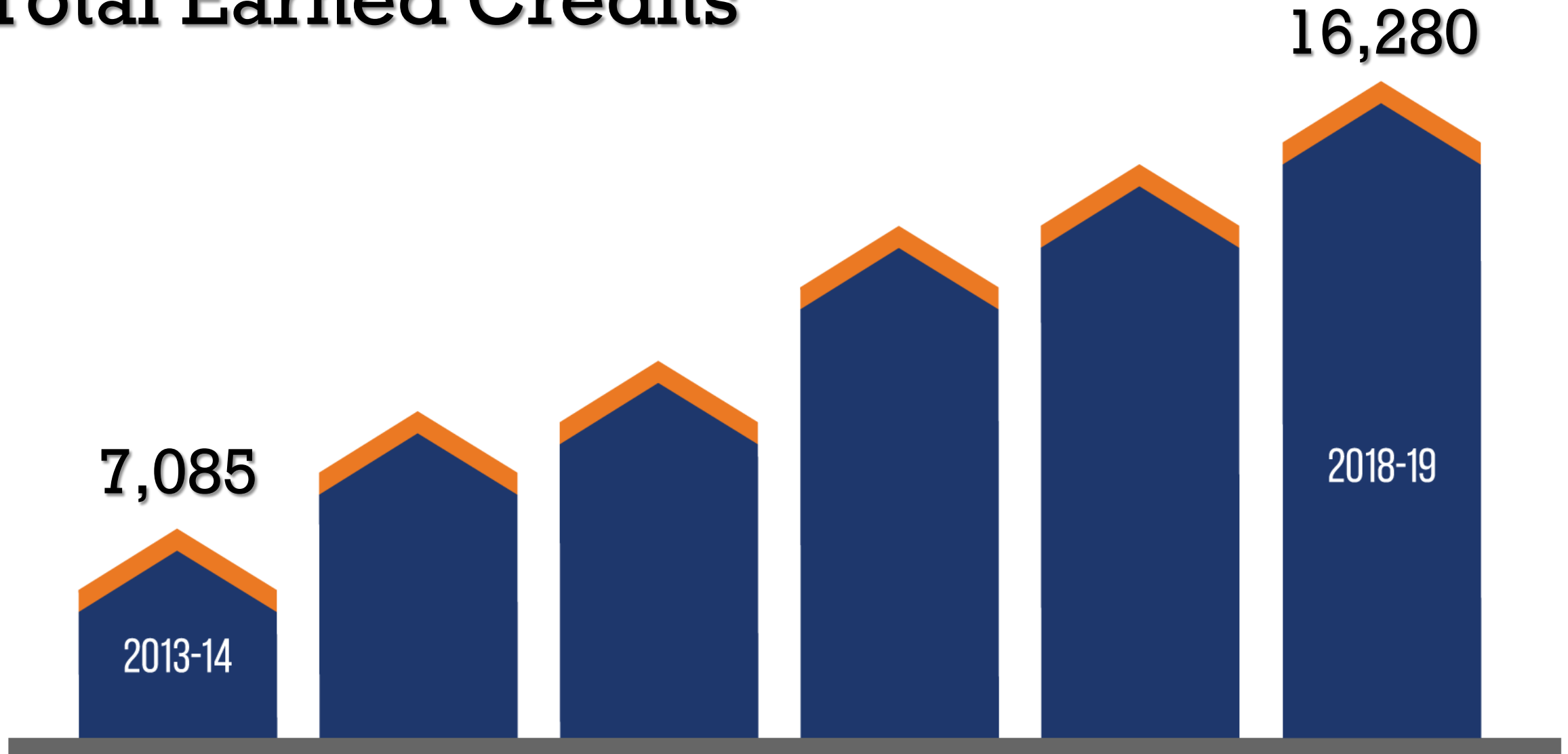
Number of Unique Students



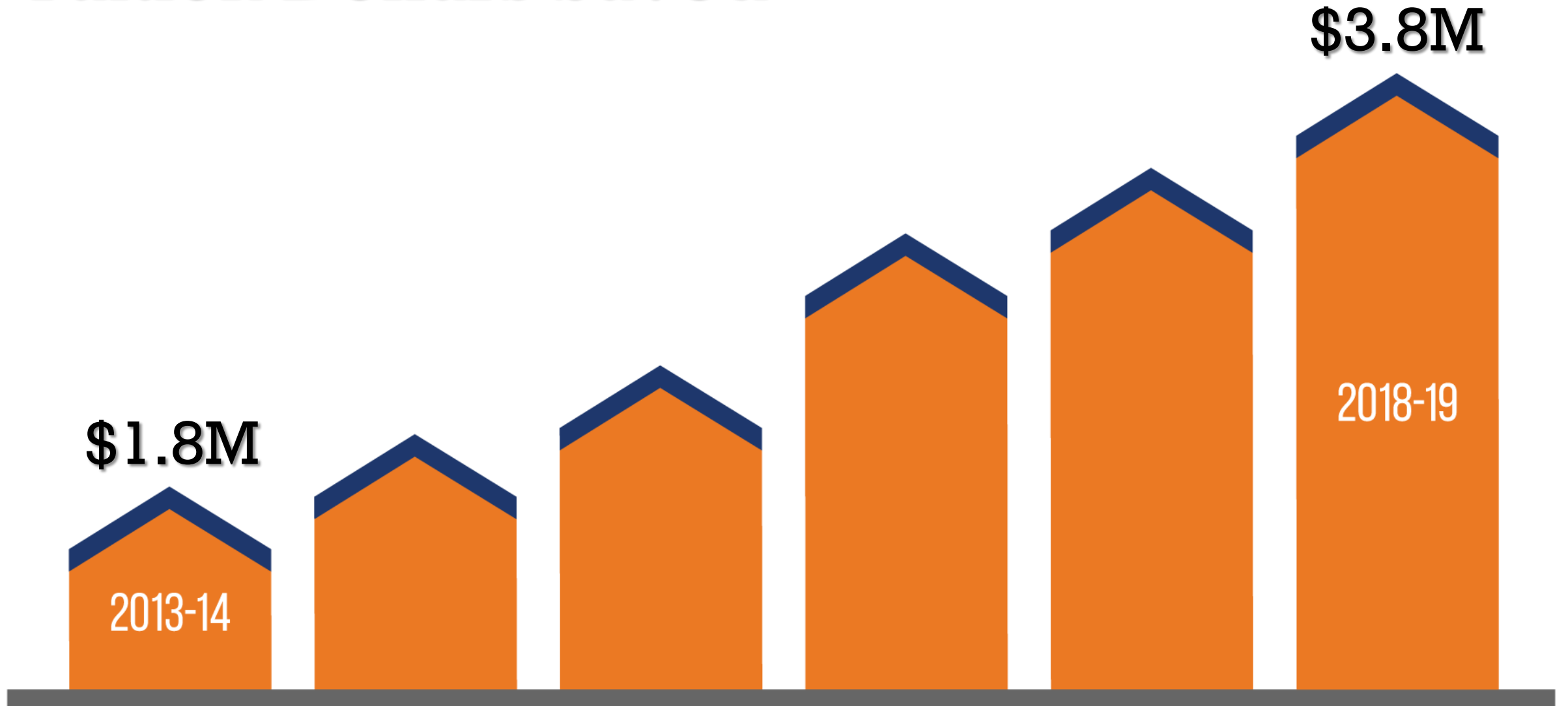
Number of Students at Rural Schools

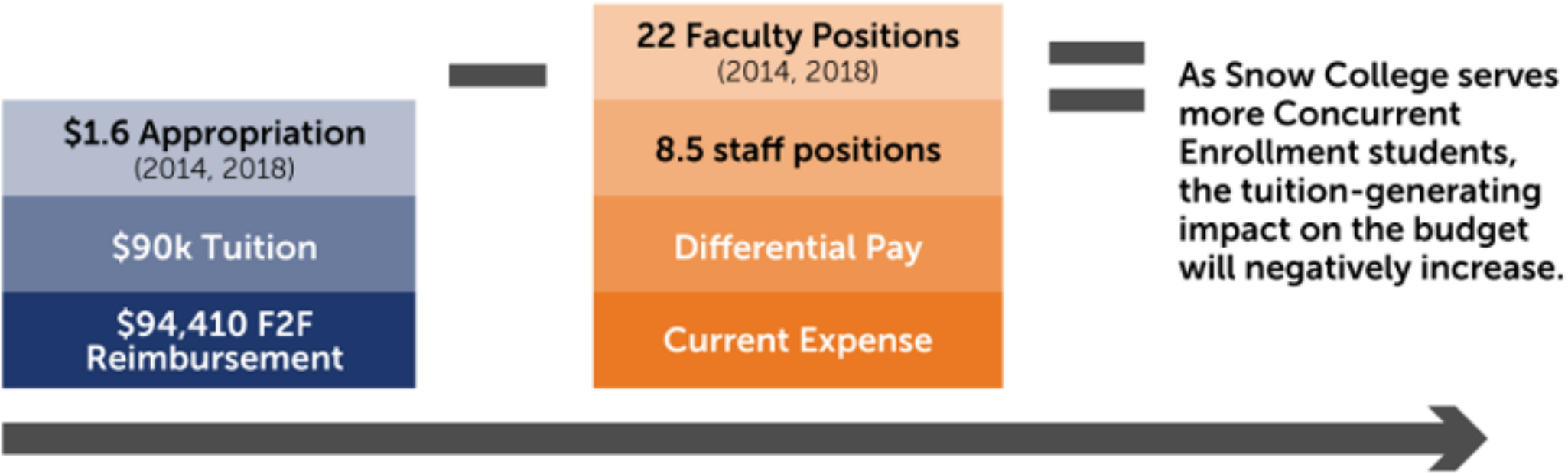

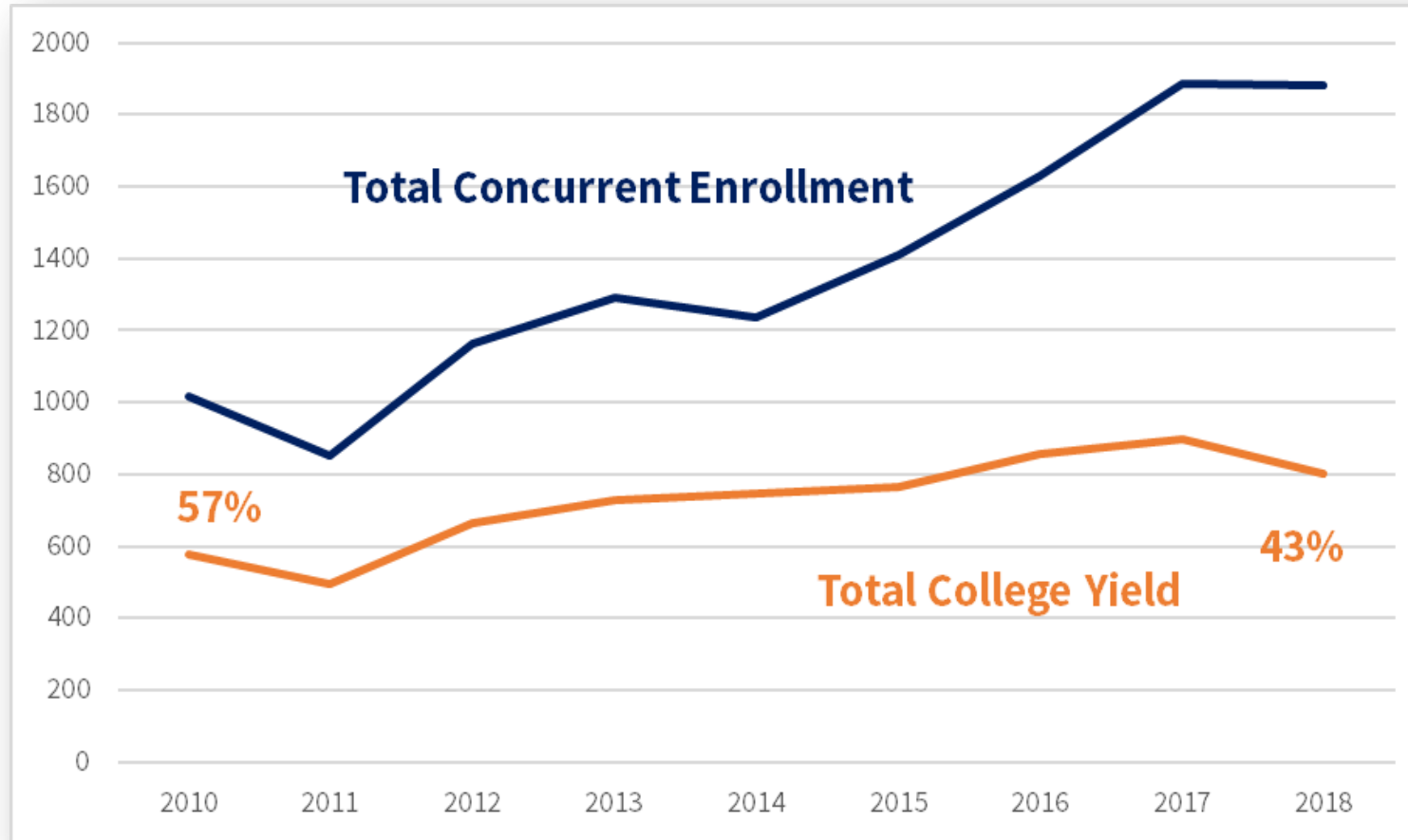

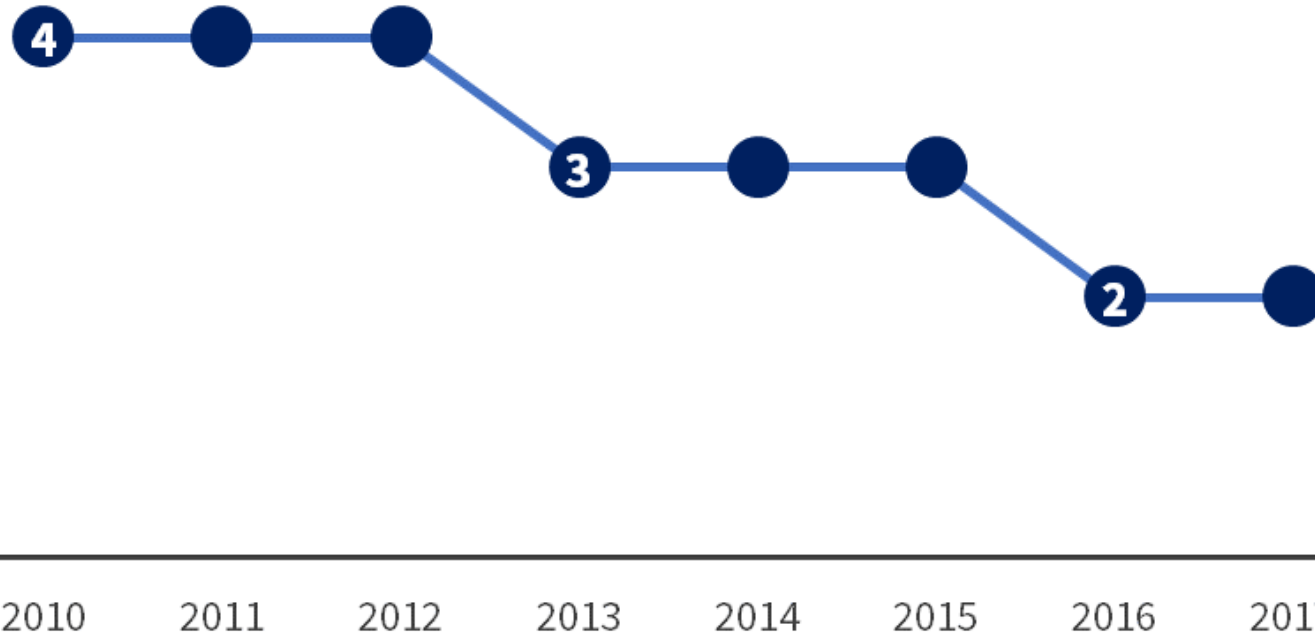


In 2010, 57% of CE students matriculated to Snow College students; in 2018, only 43% of CE students matriculated

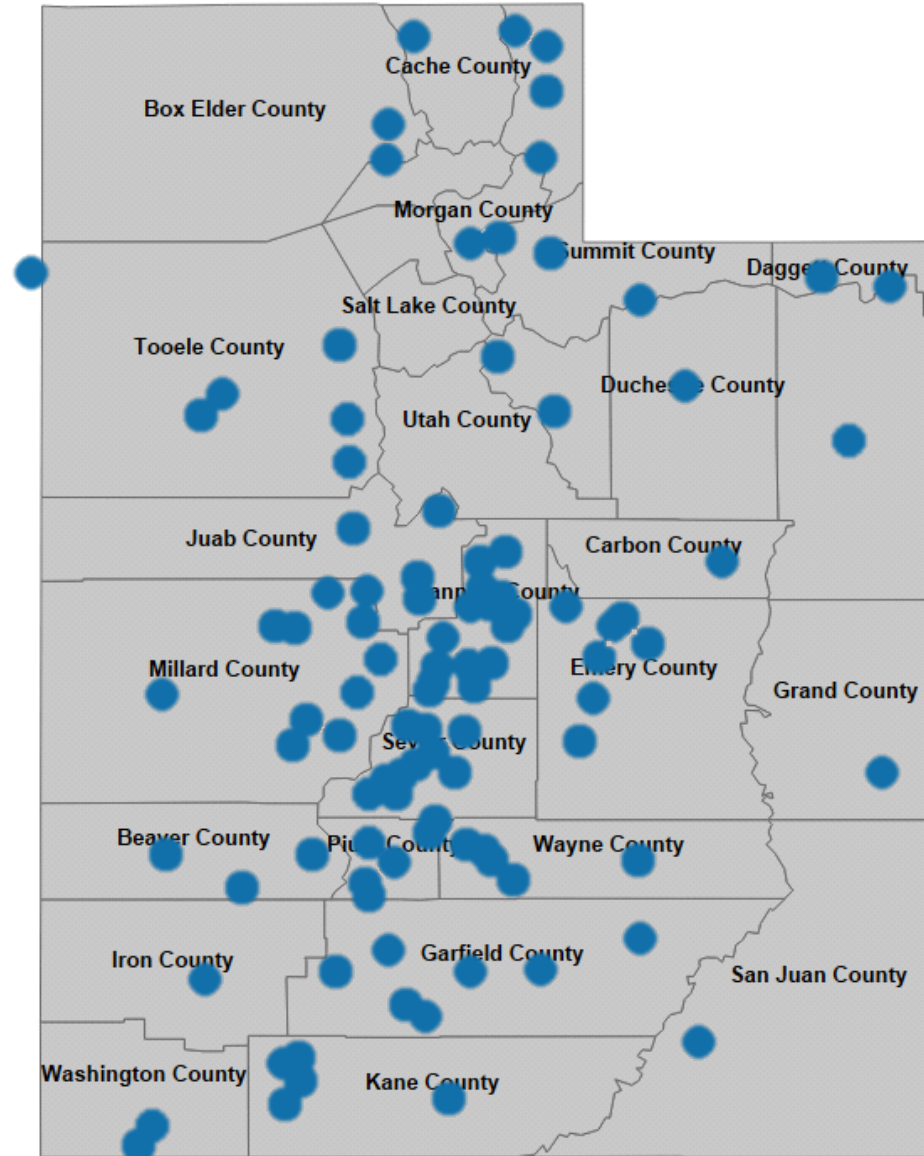
