Air Quality: monitor pollution levels and investigate individual polluters within the area. This also includes investigation and compliance enforcement for smoking violations against the Clean Indoor Air Act.

Body Art, Cosmetology, and Tanning Sanitation: inspections of facilities to ensure safety and sanitation for the public.

Daycare Inspections: ensure a clean, sanitary, and safe care environment through the regulation of food handling, water supply, heating, lighting, and general safety.

Disease Outbreak Investigations: staff works together to investigate the cause, source, and means of a disease outbreak relating to water, food, vermin/pests, and biological or chemical contaminants.

Drinking Water Testing: surveys of all water supply systems to ensure clean, healthy water and operational water delivery systems.

Food Safety Program: inspections of food service facilities to ensure proper food handling practices and sanitation, additionally review plans and complaint investigations. This program also issues food establishment permits, food handler cards, and training to food service workers.

Onsite Wastewater (Septic) Systems: administration of wastewater management program including plan approval, permitting, and final inspection for all individual onsite wastewater systems.

Public Pool: inspections for safety and sanitation of public bathing facilities including water quality and the surrounding facilities.

Solid Waste: regulates the disposal of solid waste such as municipal garbage, tires, yard waste, construction debris, contaminated soil, farming waste, and other products illegally dumped within the area.

Used Oil Recycling: compliance inspection for used motor oil collection centers and the investigation on illegal oil disposal.

Workforce Services (see housing/employment)

ABLE saving and investment solutions for people with disabilities.

The Utah Adoption Assistance Program provides help in getting a job, as well as cash payments, to a parent who has given birth to a child who has been placed for adoption.

Career and Education take the next step in your education, training or career that could lead to a dream job and higher wages.

Cash Assistance combined with supportive services and personalized case management.

Child Care helps parents cover the cost of child care.

Family Employment Program temporary cash assistance program for families.

General Assistance provides time-limited cash assistance and case management services to single adults and married couples that have no dependent children residing with them 50% or more of the time.

Homeless Prevention Emergency Assistance provides immediate help for short periods for families who don't have enough money to prevent becoming homeless or having their utilities shut off due to a crisis beyond the control of the family.

Refugee Assistance we envision a strong integrated community engaged to empower refugees' access to family-sustaining employment necessary to succeed in Utah for generations to come.

Specified Relative Program is a grandparent, sibling, uncle, aunt, or other qualified relative who has a child or children living with them and whose parents are both absent from the home.

Two Parent Program helps families increase their income and become self sufficient through employment.

Central Smiles this program provides vouchers for dental care for qualifying uninsured children ages 0-18 years old.

Children Special Health Clinic provides evaluations and clinical diagnosis for children ages 0-18. Also works to coordinate school and community support services.

Information on Opioid Overdose Prevention & Treatment Resources free Nasal Narcan kits are available at each of our locations.

Information on Diabetes prediabetes and hypertension resources in our health district.

Immunizations are available to children and adults for preventable diseases. We also offer Flu, Pneumonia and COVID-19 vaccines.

PAT (Parents as Teachers) is an early childhood parent education and family support program that can serve families from pregnancy until age three. The program provides parents with child development information and parenting support.

Self-Management Workshops the following are available: Falls Prevention, Living Well with Chronic Conditions, Stepping On, Living Well with Chronic Pain, Tai Chi, Living Well with Diabetes.
