To qualify for this scholarship, students must maintain a 2.5+ GPA, be enrolled in 12+ credits (unless specifically approved in special circumstances by the designated contact for this scholarship), be a returning student, and must not have any code of conduct issues or disciplinary action taken against them by the College. Students must fill out the Pride Club Scholarship application in its entirety and agree to the Pride Club presidency responsibilities in order to maintain scholarship support. Four \$1,000 scholarships will be given per year. If a student loses their scholarship after the fall semester, it may be awarded to another student.

4. Pride Club Presidency Responsibilities

- All presidency members will be expected to attend a minimum of 75% of all Pride Club activities unless previous arrangements have been made with advisor. They will also be expected to attend presidency meetings as they are needed-typically only a few per semester.
- All presidency members will be expected to be kind and accepting to all club members.
 Additionally, they will be expected to befriend club members and make them feel welcome. (We don't want to see the presidency all hanging out together or with only their friend group while ignoring others.)
- Each presidency member will be asked to plan at least two activities per semester.
- President will be expected to attend monthly student life coordination meeting or send another presidency member if they are unable to attend. President will also be responsible to learn how to create events in the app and manage assessments. (Advisor will teach them how to do this.)
- Vice-President will be responsible for promoting activities. (Making announcements in Canva or other software and posting them to Pride Club wall. Also posting them in events section of the app.)
- Social Media VP will manage Snow College Pride's Instagram account. They will be expected to post a minimum of once per week.
- Secretary/Treasurer will make sure we have all paperwork to Student Life, oversee the budget, track spending, and make budget requests.
