- Features spacious lobbies, game room equipment, free parking, internet, wifi, cable tv, and laundry facilities


Requirements

BADGER BUCK PLANS

Residents that live on-campus are required to purchase a Badger Buck Plan. Plans vary per building as follows:

Non-cooking Room	\$795
Cooking Apartments/Nuttall Hall	\$200

Students, parents and friends may add funds to the Badger Bucks account online at any time allowing students to make purchases at the Badger Den (cafeteria), Snow College Bookstore (books and school supplies), Badger Bistro and the Library (for copies)

Badger Bucks roll over each semester and students may cash out the remaining balance at the end of each Academic Year through an application.

HOW TO APPLY

- 1. Go to www.snow.edu/housing/apply
- 2. Complete the online housing application.
- 3. Pay your application & reservation fee.

Note: If you are relying on Federal Financial Aid to assist in covering your housing charges you MUST complete the application process BEFORE June 1 for funds to be available at the start of the fall semester. For details contact a Student Success Advisor at financialaid@snow.edu.

Note: Housing is usually still available as late as August, but we encourage all students to apply by March 1st.


