

How to Register for Fall 2023 courses -

Due to the increased availability of courses for online students, CRN #'s will no longer be provided. Students will still register for classes through their BadgerWeb account but will need to search for the online sections. Follow these steps to register:

1. Login to BadgerWeb.
2. Choose the "Student" tab.
3. Click "Registration".
4. Click "Register for Classes".
5. Choose the semester from the drop-down menu, then continue.
6. Click in the box to the right of the word "Campus".
7. Choose "Online" and click Search.
8. All online sections of courses will be listed.
9. When finding the desired course, click "Add".
10. Added courses will appear in the bottom right Summary box.
11. "Submit" must be clicked in order to successfully register for the course(s).

Waitlisting: If desired courses are already full, an error will appear in the Summary status column that says "Errors Preventing Registration". Click the drop-down menu in the "Action" column and choose "Waitlist" and submit again. When a space becomes available in the section, the student in the first position on the waitlist will receive a notification in their students.snow.edu inbox. The student has a window of just 24 hours to go back into BadgerWeb to officially add the course.

*It's important for Early College Online students to put themselves on the waitlist for their desired courses and then check their student email inboxes **DAILY**. This is how the academic affairs and registration offices will know what courses are in high demand and then work toward increasing capacity and/or creating additional course sections.
