

## Snow College Alumni Scholarship Application Information

**Application Deadline: March 1st** 

The Snow College Alumni Scholarship is available to students who have at least one parent or one grandparent (great grandparents are not included) who has graduated with an Associate's degree or higher from Snow College. Applicants must demonstrate an ability to overcome life's challenges while showing leadership and must possess an attitude of service towards others. Applicants must be enrolled at a higher education institution in Utah for the first time to be considered. Award amounts are based on available funding for the applicable academic year. In order to maintain the scholarship award, students must hold at least 12 credits per semester and maintain a 2.5 or higher GPA.

If you are awarded the Alumni Scholarship, you will receive a contract via email. Your contract will include the amount of the scholarship, the requirements to keep the scholarship, and other important information that you will need to know. Please read all instructions before answering the application questions. If awarded, you agree to be recognized on the College's social media and/or other publications and agree to provide information to the Alumni office, including a bio and picture, by the end of May. Incomplete applications will not be considered, nor returned to the applicant. Please fill out all sections completely.
